The P.G Centre was formally inaugurated by the then Vice Chancellor of Savitribai Phule Pune University (formerly University of Pune) Dr. S.C Gupte on 7th January 1994. The college M.Com is permanently affiliated to the Savitribai Phule Pune University

THE ADMISSION PROCESS

Admission to M.Com is provided on first come first served basis. No seats are reserved for the students passing B.Com from M.U.College. Students must know that the college offers specialization in the following papers at the Postgraduate level –

1. Costing and
2. Business administration

DURATION OF THE COURSE

The M.Com Course will be of Two Years' duration consisting of Two parts i.e. Part I and Part II. Each part is having Two Semester. Thus, the M.Com course is of Four Semesters. Each Semester there will be four papers of 100 marks each. Thus the M.Com Degree will be of 1600 marks. The course shall carry 64 credits in all.

Compulsory ten credits

In addition to the 64 credits, students are required to obtain ten additional credits the distribution of which is as follows –

All the courses except skill development in third and fourth semester carry one credit. Skill development in both the semesters carries two credits each.

PROJECT WORK/CASE STUDIES

- a) For regular students project work is compulsory.
- b) Project viva-voce will be conducted at the end of fourth Semester but before the Theory Examination. There will be an internal and external examiner appointed by the University and it will be conducted as per the University Programme,
- c) Project work will be of 100 marks which shall be divided as:

Synopsis with working Bibliography (internal assessment)	40 marks
A full project report (Minimum 50 to 80 Pages)	40 marks
Viva-Voce	20 marks
Total	100 marks

- d) The candidate in consultation with the project guide should do project work individually. Students should take guidance from the internal guide and prepare project report two copies to be submitted to the concerned teacher.

SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

Examination of 100 marks for each paper would be conducted in each semester. The classification of 100 marks would be an internal assessment of 40 marks and external i.e. University assessment of 60 marks. Internal assessment may be based on attendance, home assignments, class tests, long term papers, classroom presentation. 60 marks are reserved for the University Examination. The candidate will be allowed to join Part 2 of M.Com. course irrespective of the number of backlog at the First and the Second Semester.

STANDARD OF PASSING

A candidate shall be declared to have passed in the paper provided he/she has secured minimum GP of 4.5 in the university examination and grade point average of 4.0 in aggregate of university grade and internal assessment taken together.

AWARD OF CLASS

The class in respect of M.Com examination be awarded to the candidate on the basis of aggregate marks obtained by him/her in all sixteen papers all four semesters put together. A student who passes in all the courses will be declared to have passed the M.Com. degree with the following honors.
