Annual Report 2019-2020

I feel privileged to present before you Annual Report of the college activities for the Academic Year 2019-2020 briefly.

- The college is a recognized Study Center of IGNOU since 2014. The Induction Meet of newly enrolled students was organized on 19th October 2019. The college runs various Masters, Bachelors and Certificate Courses of IGNOU. Dr. N. Rajendra Prasad, Assistant Regional Director of IGNOU Regional Center Pune was present on the occasion.
- The College signed MOU for hands on training, practical knowledge and personality development of the students, cooperation, promotion and networking for improvement of quality with multiple institutions and industries like Kalyani Maxion, Cluster of English Language & Literature, Pratibha Institute of Management, and CMRS, a C. A. firm.
- The College also signed an MoU with Bajaj Finserv and offered a Certificate Programme in Banking, Finance and Insurance(CBFI) to 30 students of T.Y.B.Com. Modules included: a)Banking Operations (30 hours), b) Insurance Management (30 hrs), and c) Advanced Communication Skills (45 hrs). Completion report says the score of HR workshop & assessment are above their average. The course will continue this year too.
- This year, for the first time, the College hosted a panel discussion on proposals of Budget 2020-21in collaboration with CRMS & Associates LLP. The panelists included CA Chandrakant Doshi the former chairman of ICAI WIRC with over 45 years of work experience, Mr. Naresh Kumar Sharma, retired Chief Commissioner of Income Tax. CA Ravi Somani, a specialist in GST, Customs and Foreign Trade policy and Dr Ajit Gaikwad a faculty member of our College.
- A lecture on New Educational Policy: A Curtain Raiser was organized for the management, staff and the students.
- BBA Seminar on 'Human Resource Management' was organized on 15 September 2018. The seminar covered areas like Current Practices in Human Resources, Latest Trends in Employment Engagement and Best Practices in H.R.M. Recruitment Process.
- BBA (CA) Seminar on 'Management IT and Technology' was organized on 14 September 2019. The seminar covered topics like Information Security Management, Latest Technological Developments, Customer Relationship Management and Importance of IT in Management.

- M.Com Seminar on 'Intellectual Property Rights, Ethics, Laws and Technology' was organized on 27 January. The Speakers were Dr. Rajkumar Hirwani, Former Intellectual Property Directorate, CSIR Mr. Nilesh Pandit, Senior Manager (IPR-Patents), TCS and Dr. Ananya Bibve, Vice Principal, Modern Law College, Ganeshkhind. Also a series of lectures were organized for B.Com, BBA and BBA (CA) students to understand IPR.
- > Two lectures on Citizenship Amendment Act were organized for the students wherein lawyers were invited to satisfied students' queries regarding CAA.
- Late Mrs. Kaushalya Sangtani Inter-Collegiate Quiz Competition was held on 20th September 2019. We are conducting this quiz since last 10 years and has become a most awaited event in PCMC & Pune. This year 53 teams participated in this event. Team Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune stood as winner and H. R. College of Economics and Commerce, Mumbai as runners up.
- Reflexion is our signature intercollegiate event. It was organized on 14 December 2019. The event included competitions, namely, PPT, Creative Advertisements, Elocution, Themebased Rangoli, Programming competition and Mono Acting. 147 students from PCMC & Pune participated in this event. The Reflexion Rolling trophy was bagged by BMCC, Pune & Runners Up trophy by Pratibha College.
- Convocation Ceremony was held on 11 February 2020. Students were awarded degree at the hands of Dr. Parag Kalkar, Dean, Commerce and Management, SPPU. Hon. Mrs. Nalini Gera, President, JHSE Trust and Mrs. Aruna Jethwani, Chairperson, College Committee were also present on the occasion.
- The college conducted a Short Term Course in Sindhi Language Learning funded by NCPSL, Certificate course in Financial Planning in collaboration with CMRS, Smart English for Effective Communication in collaboration with ELTIS, "Train to Her" in association with CCA, Dr. M. R. Jayakar Employability Skills program funded by SPPU, and Short Term Courses in Tally, Yoga and Stress Management, Entrepreneurship Development, Advance Excel, Programming, Personal Branding, Value Education, Employability and Skill Development, Certificate Programme in Indian Stock Market jointly with NISM & also Induction Programme for FY B Com, BBA & BCA students.
- A one-day Theater workshop was conducted for the students wherein students of eight colleges participated.
- Various guest lectures on Cyber Law, Women empowerment, Laws to Protect Women, Cost Management, Capital Gains, Equal Opportunity in Education and Employment, Competitive Examinations, Career Opportunities in IT, Online Banking, Research Skill, GST Training, Communication Skills, Music Appreciation, Recent Amendments in Company Law,

Computer Networking, Career Opportunities & Revised Accreditation pattern were organized. The college also organized various competitions like Elocution, PowerPoint Presentation, Quiz, Extempore and Essay Writing.

- > The college celebrated Nation Voters Day and Mahitidoot awareness programme.
- Literary Association was inaugurated on 30 August 2019. Various activities like Poetry Recitation Competition, Book Review Competition. Marathi Pandharvada and Hindi Sapthaha were celebrated. Marathi Divas and Hindi Diwas Sindhi Shahdad Day were also observed. Sindhology Trophy Competition was held on 5 February 2020.
- > Under Students' Welfare Department, Earn and Learn scheme was successfully completed.
- Industrial Visits to Kalyani Maxion Wheels Ltd. Chakan Pune, Thyssen Krupp Industries, Stella Enterprise, Sun Automation, Panjarpol Goshala, River Walk, EVS Visit at Baner, Bee Training Center and a study tour to the National Institute Securities Market, Mumbai was organized.
- NSS special winter camp was held at Jambawade Village, Maval, Pune from 13th January 2020 to 19th January 2020. Different activities like Awareness Lectures, Cleanliness Drives and Educational Surveys were conducted during the camp. NSS also organized events like Swatch Bharat Abhiyaan Rally, Tree Plantation Drive. Essay writing competition & Quiz competition.
- Under EVS Paper Bag Making Workshop and Best out of waste workshop were organized. Various lectures like holistic climate, waste management, save earth and water and water recycling were organized.
- The College also organized activities like International Yoga Day, Personal Counselling, Firefighting Demo, and Job Fair. Under Vidyarthini Manch, students were enlightened about women-related issues.
- Under Placement Cell, various counseling sessions were organized for the students. Two students were placed in Cybage, 10 in ICICI Prudential and 260 interviews were conducted by nine other companies under Job Fair and 106 of these were shortlisted.

- > Under "Success stories" three of our alumni delivered lectures for our students.
