

Annual Report 2020-2021

I feel privileged to present before you Annual Report of the college activities for the Academic Year 2020-2021 briefly.

- The academic year started during the pandemic right in time and we could start teaching to second & third year students from the first day of the session because all the students were promoted to the next level and admission process was complete till then.
- The University granted us approval for starting BA. The government approval is awaited. We also received approval from National Skill Qualifications Framework, UGC for starting B.Voc in Retail management (three years integrated degree course) and short term certificate courses in fields of Banking and Finance, Direct Tax Laws, Data Analysis and Interpretation and Classical Music. The Courses will be started next year.
- The college conducted 2 national level seminars online:
 - 1. A Two day National webinar on 'Role of NSS: COVID 19 Crisis and Post Pandemic Action Plan' was organized on 02 & 03 June 2020. 5 speakers were invited and 98 NSS program officers and other faculty attended the webinar. The coordinator was the NSS team under the guidance of the NSS Program Officer Dr. Leena Modi.
 - 2. A One day National Webinar on "Mutual Fund Insights" was organized on 16August 2020 in collaboration with National Institute of Securities Market, Mumbai'. 4 speakers were invited and 289 participants attended the webinar. It was coordinated by Department of Economics and Banking under the guidance of Mr. Azhar Khan.
- The college conducted 4 Workshops for the students :
 - 1. A 15 session workshop on Image Branding for S.Y.B.Com. & B.B.A. students.
 - 2. A 12 session workshop on Google Tools in which 53 students participated.
 - 3. A one day session on Budget in which 75 students participated.
 - 4. A one day workshop on Financial Literacy along with Symbiosis college for B.B.A. Students.
- Apart from regular teaching, our teachers conducted 11 short term courses for which they designed syllabus, conducted 15 sessions for each course, and coordinated 5 short term courses wherein the resource persons were invited from specialized domains.
- 13 credit courses were conducted for the students which were made a compulsory part of the syllabus by the university. For 9 courses, the resource persons were invited from specialized domains.
- 7 career counseling sessions were held covering almost all the aspects of commerce stream including one on civil services. Online interviews were conducted by some of the companies and some students were placed.
- 9 guest lectures and a week-long workshop was conducted by our alumni. They also purchased 2 oxygen concentrators by raising donations amongst themselves & the Management and donated the same to the institute to help the needy. Many of them have been constantly working for arrangements of

plasma, providing hospital beds to covid patients and thus helping them during the pandemic.

- Our teachers published 10 books, 8 research papers, attended 14 workshops, 29 faculty development programs, 52 webinars and 6 teachers were invited as resource persons by other universities and colleges. 1 teacher completed a minor research project and post graduate certificate in teaching. 3 junior clerks also attended workshops.
- 30 widows & poor women received financial assistance worth more than a lac and 10 students received Scholarship from Indusind Foundation through the efforts of our college. 20 students received scholarship worth a lac from Jai Hind Trust.
- This report cannot be complete without mentioning the names of our students who brought us laurels.
 - 1. Ms. Chaudhary Santosh (2019 batch) received 2 gold medals & 4 prizes for securing highest marks in Advance Accountancy sponsored by various agencies.
 - 2. Ms. Archana Hegde (2019 batch) is awarded The Shri Paramhans Yoganand Prize for securing highest marks and standing Third amongst all the successful candidates & passed the B. Com Examination in First Class with distinction.

By the end of the academic year the pandemic hit some of the staff members. Most of them could defeat the virus while we lost Dr. Geetha Sivaraman on 9th June and Senior Clerk Mr. Amit Kachare lost his wife who was only 34. Some more staff members lost the senior members of their family. We all were deeply grieved and held condolence meet for all of them.

I thank the all the members of the management for their timely guidance, support and co-operation. I thank all my colleagues, teaching and Non-teaching staff, students and parents for their whole hearted support and co-operation.
