# Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) Between

## M. U. College of Commerce, Pimpri, Pune And

## T Mart, Pimpri, Pune

This MoU is signed between the **T Mart, Pimpri, Pune** and Jai Hind Sindhu Education Trust's **M. U. College of Commerce, Pimpri, Pune** – 411017 (hereafter 'the college).

As part of this MoU, T Mart, Pimpri, Pune, will provide support to the college to promote and offer skill education as part of Higher Education without any cost to the college in form of the following:

- a) To facilitate internships or apprenticeship to the B.Voc. (Retail Management) students of the college,
- b) To act as a bridge between the students finishing vocational education at the higher secondary level and facilitating their continued vocational education as part of higher education and
- c) To support organizing events like career fair, skill competition and recognition of talents in vocational education,

### FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

This Agreement is signed strictly without any financial obligation between the college and T Mart, Pimpri, Pune.

#### OTHER COVENANTS

- a) The use of the name, logo and/or official emblem of any of the parties on any publication, document and/or paper is allowed only after seeking explicit permission in writing by either party.
- b) This Agreement does not create any legal obligation between the parties. Any difference or dispute between the parties concerning the interpretation and/or implementation and/or application of any of the provisions of this Agreement shall be settled amicably through mutual consultation or negotiations between the parties without reference to any third party.
- c) Both the parties are entering into this Agreement in a good faith and intentions. Neither party will be responsible for any liabilities arising out of death, injury or any legal action in respect of field staff, trainees or any other persons associated with the operationalization of this Agreement.
- d) This Agreement will come into effect on date of signature by all the partners and will end after 5 years from the date of signing of this Agreement. Upon review, this can be extended further to 5 years.
- e) Each party might bring this MoU to an end by giving a 30 day notice to the other parties via written notice in an appropriate manner.
