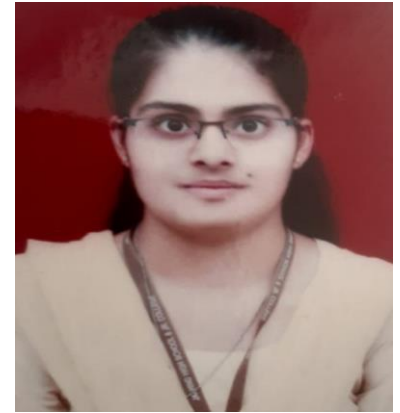
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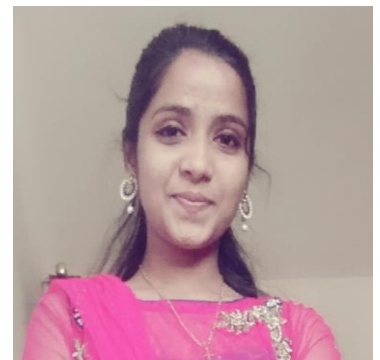

Annual Report 2021-2022

I feel privileged to present before you the Annual Report of the college activities for the Academic year 2021-2022, in brief:

- The academic year started during the pandemic right in time and we could start teaching online to second & third year students from the first day of the session. We had good response for admissions for B.Com 1264 , BBA 253, BBA(CA) 52, M. Com. 120 and Grand Total 1689.



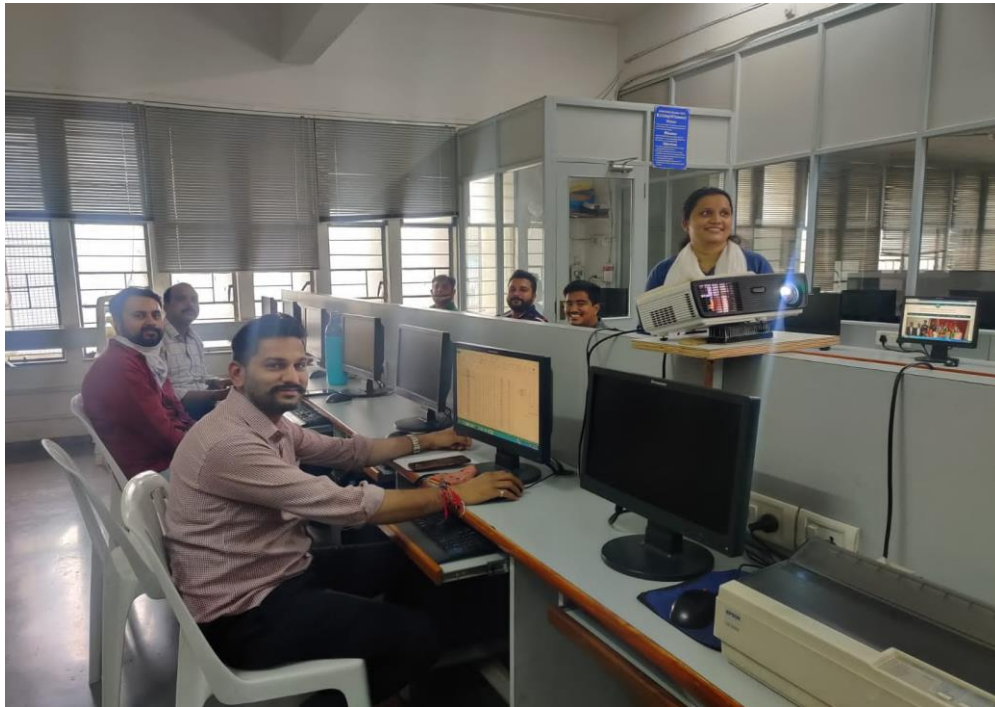
- The college conducted 2 national level seminars online: A one-day National webinar on “Optimizing Social Media for Teaching, Learning; Personal Branding” was organized on 20/08/2021 by the Department of Commerce coordinated by Dr. Rekha Chetwani; Dr. Pushpa Pamnani. Adv. Vadana Chavan, Member of Rajya Sabha. Mr. Satish Narayan, CEO; Founder Nectar Pixel Media Pvt Ltd, Ms. Shehnaaz Chawla, President Golden Heart Foundation, Dr. Rakesh Damir, Prof. of English, Gujarat University; Dr. Ashok Sachdeva Professor of English, Devi Ahilya University Indore were the speakers during 4 session. Vaedictory Address was by Mr. Mukund Deshpande, Head Corporate Marketing, and Forbes Marshall. 102 participants (47 from Pune District, 27 from other Districts, 28 participants out of State) attended the seminar.
- A One day National Webinar on Accounting Standards and International Financial Reporting Standards (IFRS) in collaboration with Pimpri Chinchwad Branch of WIRC of ICAI was organized on 9/10/2021. Speakers were Chairman CA. Chandrakant B.Kale Pimpri Chinchwad Branch of WIRC of ICAI, Dr. Yashodhan Mithare Associate Dean Faculty of Commerce and Management SPPU, Dr. Jagbir Singh Kadyan, Swami Shraddhanand College, University of Delhi and Dr. Shailendra Kumar Bharal Professor, School of Studies in Commerce Vikram University Ujjain. 257 participants from 25 states attended the webinar. It was organized by the Department of Commerce; coordinated Dr. Deepa Nathwani.

- A state level workshop on “The Role of Non-Teaching Staff in Quality Enhancement” in Collaboration with Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar College, Aundh was organized on 23/10/2021. 4 speakers were invited and around 125 nonteaching staff from various colleges participated. Dr. Dnyaneshwar Shirode was the coordinator from the college side.
- A college level seminar on “Research Methodology for Commerce & Management” was organized for BBA/BCA students on 12/4/2022. 3 speakers were invited. Our Faculty members & 91 students participated. Dr. Palak Chhablani coordinated the seminar.
- The college conducted 6 Workshops for the students: i) A Fifteen-session workshop on Google Tools attended by 55 students guided by in-house faculty ii) A one-day workshop on Script Writing attended by 34 students. Resource person was Ms. Dhanashree Gund, Alumna, University of London iii) A one-day workshop on Intellectual Property Rights, which was attended by 149 students. Resource person was Miss. Pooja Maulikar, Staff, Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Intellectual Property Management, Nagpur iv) A one-day workshop on Budget in which 125 students participated. Resource persons were CA Rishi Lodha & CA Pankaj Agarwal v) A half-day workshop on Prevention of Sexual Harassment at Workplace, which was attended by 103 students. Resource persons were Adv. Dr. Ruby Chattwal and Adv. Priti Mandan vi) 89 students attended a one-day workshop on Gender Sensitivity sponsored by SPPU.



- The college conducted certain activities for teaching & non-teaching staff under Staff Academy: i) Two-Day Orientation on NAAC Procedures, ii) 7 days training programme on MS Excel for non-teaching staff, iii) A Guest Lecture on “Developing Research culture among teachers

- Apart from regular teaching, the college conducted 18 short-term courses including a Certificate Program in Banking, Finance & Insurance by Bajaj Finserv, a short-term course on Powerful Presence by Mrs. Poonam Kishinchandani and a course in Financial Literacy by Dr. Ravi Ahuja. A retired teacher Adv. Ashok Tarani conducted a course in General Awareness in Law. One of the alumni Mrs. Jaya Dhanani conducted one course.
- 13 credit courses were conducted for the students, which were made a compulsory part of the syllabus by the university. For nine courses, the resource persons were invited from specialized domains.



- Sindhi Matrubhasha Divas, Behrana Sahib, Marathi Bhasha Samvardhan Pandharwada and Hindi Diwas were observed to celebrate the Indian languages, Culture and their importance.
- Nine career-counseling sessions covering almost all the aspects of commerce stream including one on civil services, 25 Curriculum related Guest Lectures, 07 Lectures on general topics, which include IPR, Cyber Awareness, Voting awareness, were held. HDB Financial Services, ADP, ICICI Prudential, Bolt Innovative Transformations conducted online interviews and 15 students were placed.
- NSS activities include a one week non-residential camp at Akurdi from 18 to 24 Feb., World Environment Day cleanliness Drive, World Bicycle Day, E-waste collection drive, Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava Fit India Run.
- Yuva Samvad was held wherein the guest speaker was Amar Chikhale , Global Youth Ambassador & National Youth Award Winner, A Guest lecture on National Voters Day, World Aids Day and Reading Day Activity and quiz on Dr. A.P.J Abdul Kalam Birth Anniversary

- Culfest was celebrated with a lot of enthusiasm. A host of competitions and cultural activities were organized in the span of 2 days from 22 nd to 23 April 2022.
- The Gymkhana committee organized following programs: i) Inter zone chess competition was hosted by the college from 1 to 3 January 2022, ii) Inter class team and individual events, iii) National Sports Day
- The College organized two Industrial Visits: one each to Kalyani Maxion; K.K.Plant. A group of students was sent to travel and understand the Metro project.
- The College organized a good number of activities in collaboration with the alumni association, PCMC Smart Sarthi with whom we signed a MOU and with Rotary Club of Pimple Saudagar. A BMI checkup; Blood donation camp was organized in association with MUCC Alumni Association on the occasion of World Health Day while PCMC Smart Sarthi Merchant Module program was organized for the Entrepreneurs of Pimpri. One of the Alumnus Mr. Satish Jamnani instituted a cash prize of INR 10,000/- every year for the outstanding sports person of the year.
- Thirty widows & poor women received financial assistance worth more than a lac from IndusInd Foundation.

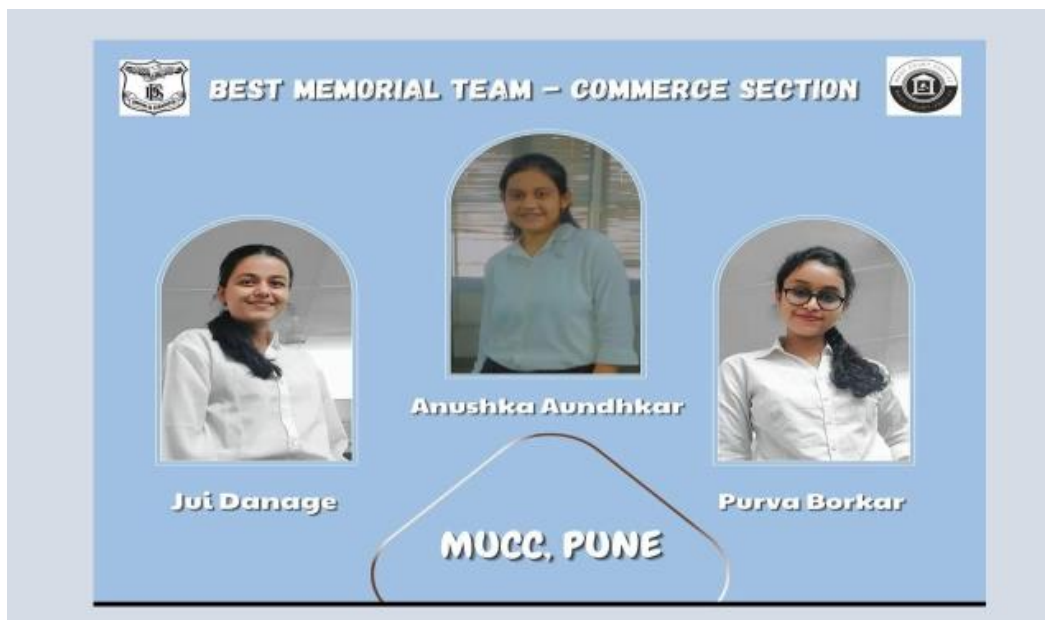

Board of Students' Development Coordinator: Dr. Rekha Chetwani

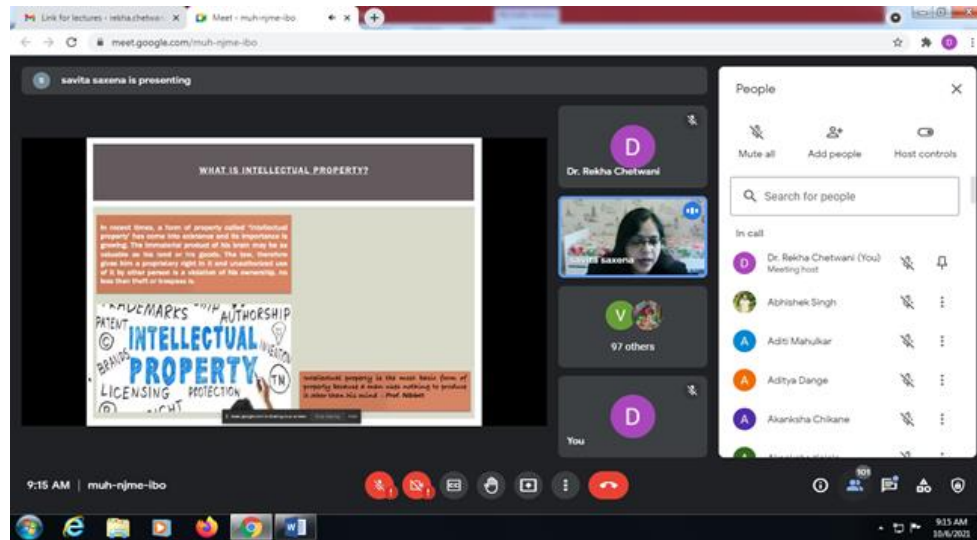

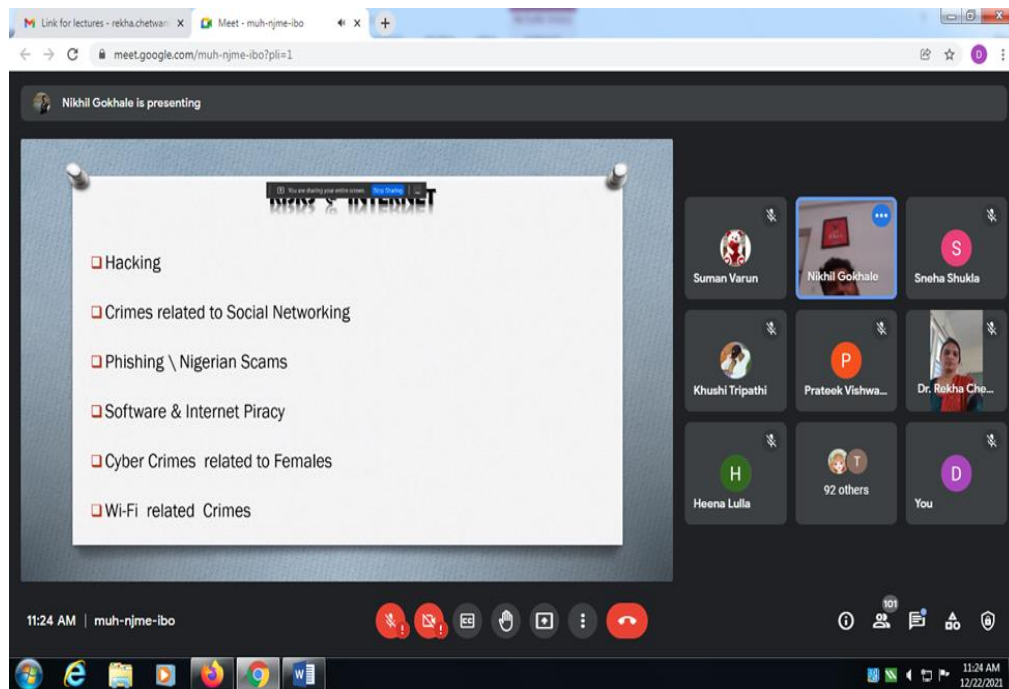

Optimizing Social Media for Teaching-Learning and Personal Branding

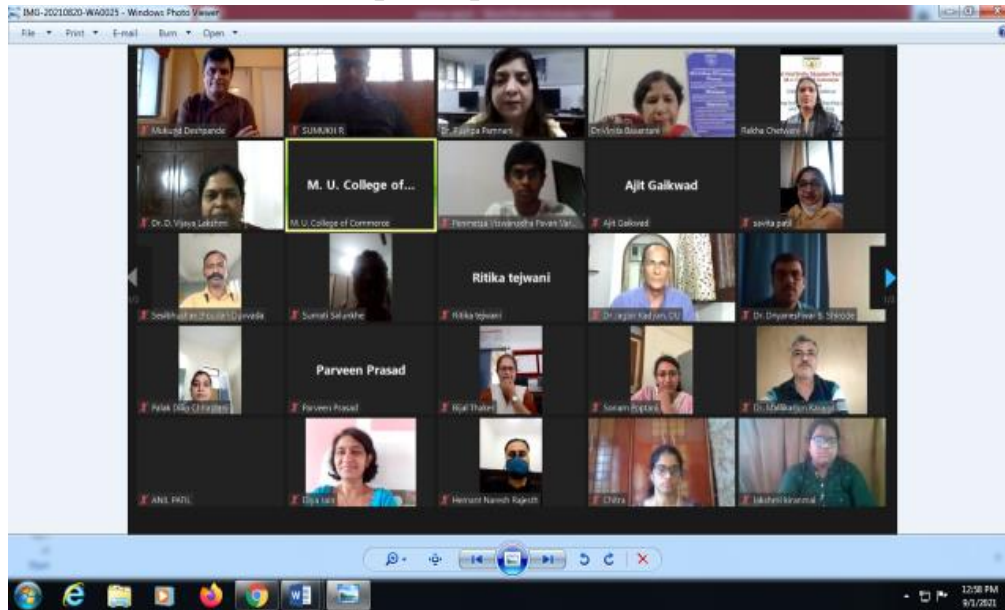

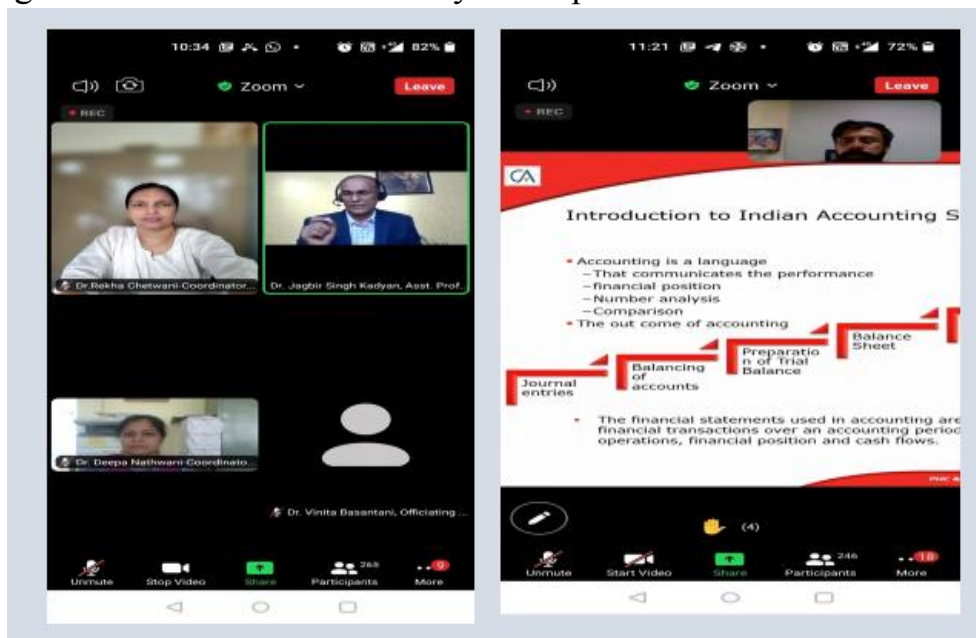

University Ujjain graced the valedictory function. He spoke about how important it is to know about Accounting Standards and IFRS in today's competitive world.

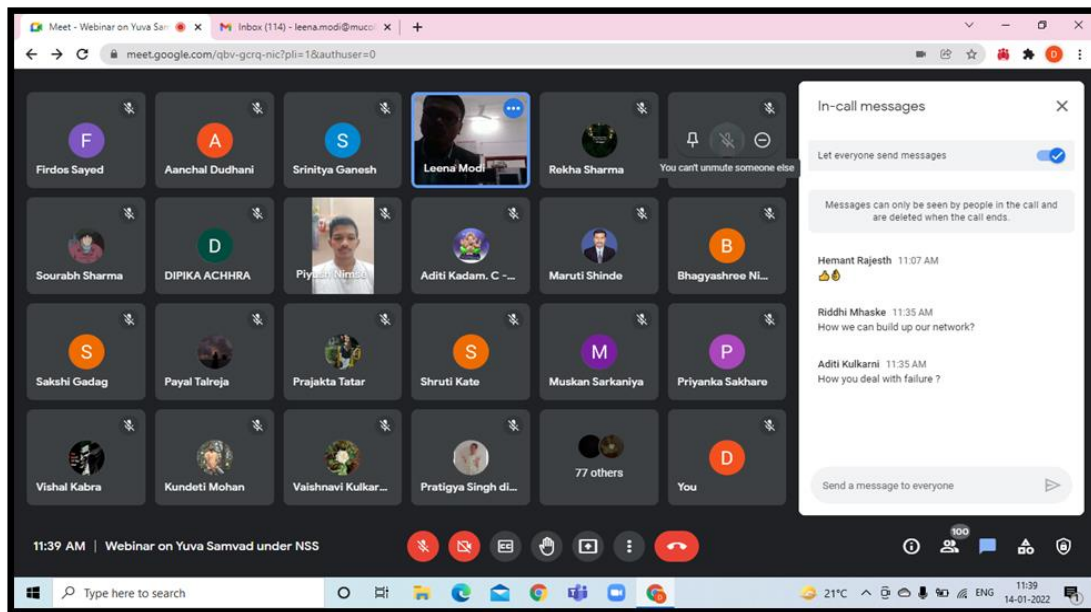

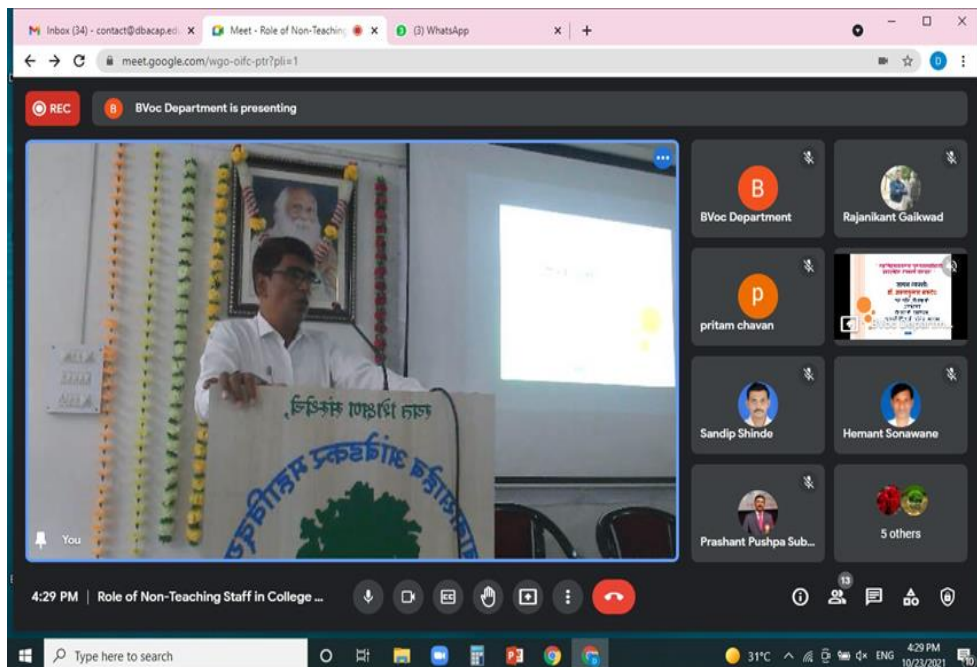

Dr. Ambedkar the architect of India's Labour Forum

Labour Day or May Day is a celebration of the working classes that is promoted by the international labour movement. If there any person who secured the rights of Laborers in India, the person was none other than “Father of Modern India” & Revolutionary Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar. Without Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar, today the future of India Labors would have been in pitch darkness. He is the only leader in India who was multi-dimensional and a great visionary. After all he was born in the land of the most congenial cattiest the nation we know as ‘India’. The staunch upper caste's never give credit to Dr. Ambedkar's contribution in building a great nation which today is one of the developing economies of the world. Thanks to his robust economic policies which have saved India even in the times of great Economic Depressions. Be it the founding guidelines of the RBI or the Principles of Free Trade, Dr. Ambedkar has given all the best for our Nation. Great Dr Bhimrao Ramji Ambedkar was not only the maker of the Indian Constitution but was also the visionary architect of India's labor law reforms. He was the savior of the Indian labor, and not a mere Dalit leader. Many of the important labor law initiatives in India were made by Dr Ambedkar himself, being the first Labor Minister of India in the Viceroy's Executive Council during the four years from 1942 to 1946. Those four years can be termed as the golden period of Indian labour. Each floor was having a single lavatory and single tap for bathing, washing and cleaning cooking utensils. Most of the tenants were mill workers. Living under these conditions, the professor acquired a first-hand experience about the hardships in the lives of the workers. He had occasions to visit some of the mills and see how the workers were working there. This has created a passion in him to work for the welfare of workers. He thus gained the confidence of many workers and rose to their leadership. This life experience created the background for him to become India's architect of labor law reforms. In August 1936, he founded a new political party called the Independent Labor Party. He drafted an action program to address the grievances of the landless, poor tenants, farmers and workers. In the initial election itself, fifteen out of seventeen candidates put up by the party succeeded including Dr Ambedkar. He got established as a reputed labor leader. In 1938, the Congress Government presented the Industrial Disputes Bill with many anti-worker clauses in the Bombay Legislative Assembly. Dr Ambedkar accused the bill as “bad, bloody and bloodthirsty” since it restricted the right of the laborer to strike and made the strike illegal as well as impossible. The bill also enabled the employer not to disclose his budget and sought to use police force against the workers. Still, the Congress Government went forward with the bill. As a part of the campaign against the law, a one day strike was also held. Addressing the Indian Labour Conference held in New Delhi on November 26, 1945, Ambedkar emphasised the urgent need to bring progressive labour welfare legislation: “Labour may well say that the fact that the British took 100 years to

have a proper code of labour legislation is no argument that we should also in India take 100 years. History is not always an example. More often it is a warning.”In his short spell as member (Labour) of the Viceroy’s Executive Council (July 1942 - June 1946), he undertook major steps towards protecting the interests of the labour and made this period a remarkable period in the history of labour welfare legislations. He made sure that the government takes the responsibility of ensuring the right to prescribe fair wages and fair conditions of service. His contribution towards various labour issues was immense. Some of the important Acts he contributed to were The Indian Trade Union (Amendment) Act, The Factories Act, The Payment of Wages Act, The Protection of Minimum Wages Act, etc. During this period and later on, he promoted trade unionism and tripartism. Ambedkar was a votary of free movement of labour. He stressed upon skill up-gradation and mechanization. Ambedkar had an instrumental role in establishing employment exchanges, which helped in the resettlement of services personnel and discharged war workers. This was in sync with the requirement of the then job market and the industry. His views are even more relevant today when the country is facing an expanding youth population and a rapidly changing job market, specially in the present pandemic economic situation. Ambedkar’s concern for labour was not only at the policy level but also at the political level. He floated the Independent Labour Party (ILP) in August 1936 which projected itself as a party of workers. The programme of the ILP, published in 1937, described it as a ‘labour welfare organization. It supported state ownership and management where ever necessary, and the working class, more so the ‘unorganised sector’. His views on protecting the interest of the labour was expressed in a weekly named “Janata” founded by him in the 1930s. However, due to the then Indian situation, where the religious and social order sanctified the division of labourer instead of the division of labour, Ambedkar had to change his course later on, to address the issue of caste. This was one of the reasons that the Independent Labour Party made way for the Scheduled Castes Federation (SCF) in the 1940s. Reduction in Factory Working Hours (8 hours duty) : Today the working hours in India per day is about 8 hours. We do not know that how many Indians know, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar was the Savior of Labors in India. He brought 8 hours duty in India and change the working time from 14 hours to 8 hours became a light for workers in India. He brought it on the 7th session of Indian Labor Conference in New Delhi, November 27, 1942. In his short spell as member (Labour) of the Viceroy’s Executive Council (July 1942 - June 1946), he undertook major steps towards protecting the interests of the labour and made this period a remarkable period in the history of labour welfare legislations. He made sure that the government takes the responsibility of ensuring the right to prescribe fair wages and fair conditions of service. His contribution towards various labour issues was immense. Some of the important Acts he contributed to were The Indian Trade Union (Amendment) Act, The Factories Act, The Payment of Wages Act, The Protection of Minimum Wages Act, etc. During this period and later on, he promoted trade unionism and tripartism. Ambedkar was a votary of free movement of labour. He stressed upon skill up-gradation and mechanization.
