## Annual Report 2022-2023

I feel privileged to present before you Annual Report of the college activities for the Academic Year 2022-2023 briefly.

> The teaching commenced for S. Y. & T. Y. B. Com, BBA and S. Y. M. Com in spite of the results not declared. The university academic year was started on August 25, 2022. We started teaching to second & third year students immediately though the admission process was yet to start. The college notified the students that they could start attending the lectures while the processes may take time so that there is no academic loss. We had good response for admissions and thus we had following number of students this year:

> I could not present the results last year, as the exams were not over until then. This year also, the exams are still in progress. Hence presenting last year's results.

- ➤ Sindhi theatre workshop was conducted in collaboration with Jai Hind High School, Mr. Harish Kakwani and his troop from Sindhu Vision Academy, Ahmedabad trained the students from 13 to 15 August. The workshop ended with a variety show by the trained students and Gaurav Gaan by Mr. Kakwani and his troop. It was attended by the local community in person and through YouTube.
- > On the occasion of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava, August 15, 2022 Flag formation program and Rally was organized in the college. Under Har Ghar Zenda program Flag were distributed to the students. Around 200 students and teachers participated in the program.
- > The college inducted the students of B. Com & BBA. Their parents were also invited and the college procedures related to lectures, practicals, continuous evaluation and all other activities were explained to them.
- ➤ The college conducted 2 students' seminars this year:
- 1. A Post Graduate Seminar was organized for the Students on Wednesday, 3rd May, 2023, titled as "Basic Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights: Different way to protect your Ideas". The **First Session** was conducted by Adv. Dr. Ananya Bibave, Principal of Modern Law College, Ganeshkhind. She interacted with the students on the topic 'Copy Rights". The **Second Session** was conducted by Adv. Dr. Dinesh Paniker. He discussed the different well-known cases regarding intellectual Property Rights. The **Third session**

- was conducted by Adv. Dr. Shradha Damle who detailed on 'Patents', like how to register the patents and for what the patents are given.
- 2. A seminar on 'E-Commerce in Emerging Markets' was conducted for BBA students on 4th May,2023. The first speaker for the seminar Dr. Shitalkumar Rawandale, Dean Industry Institute interaction PCET, Pune and President-Maharashtra Association of TPOs emphasized on the Importance and Contemporary trends of E-Commerce. The second speaker Mr. Ameya Chandrakant Tambe, Director, Softech Data Securities spoke on Cyber Security and Technology. The last speaker for the seminar Dr. Pranita Burbure, from S.B.Patil Institute of Management spoke on E-Marketing and E-payments.
- A lecture on Uniform Civil Code was organized to make the citizens aware of the pros and cons in implementation of Uniform Civil Code. It was attended by the Sr. Citizens in good numbers.
- > To make students understand the challenges after marriage, a Pre-Marriage counselling session was conducted for parents, Grandparents and the students. Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, SPPU sponsored the program.
- The College also conducted a few workshops for the staff & students:
- 1. A Fifteen-session workshop on Google Tools attended by 58 students guided by in-house faculty. (NO)
- 2. A one-day theatre workshop was conducted. Resource person was Mr. Vidyanidhee Vanarase (Prasad), an alumnus of National School of Drama, New Delhi.
- 3. A one-day workshop on Budget analysis was attended 91 students. Resource persons were CA Divyesh Tripathi and CA Himanshu Chodhary.
- 4. 3 sessions were organized under Nirbhay Kanya Abhiyan on prevention of sexual harassment & the procedure for grievance redressal. The lecture also aimed at informing students about role of ICC and zero tolerance policy of the college towards Sexual Harassment. The lectures were followed by a session on Self-defense techniques. The sessions were conducted by Adv. Savita Saxena, Adv. Priti Mandhan and Mr. Amit Vitule respectively.
- 5. A workshop on Candle and Chocolate making & one on perfume making was attended by 50 & 39 students respectively.
- 6. *DIPOTSAV* an exhibition cum sale for all students was organised on 15th October, 2022. 16 stalls were put up by 34 students participated. They exhibited the Diwali related articles like lanterns, Diyas, snacks, sweets, readymade rangoli, chocolate, candles and decorative items with Mehandi Drawing. Staff members, students and parents enjoyed the exhibition.
- 7. Apart from regular teaching, the college conducted 12 short-term courses including a Certificate Program in Banking, Finance & Insurance by Bajaj Finserv, Certificate Course in Sindhi Language, Autonomous courses in Entrepreneurship Development, Yoga & Meditation, Certificate Course in Direct Tax Laws in India, Labour Laws and Dr. M R Jayakar Employability Programme
- 8. Apart from the personal counselling sessions for students, staff, alumni and parents, 5 group counseling sessions were held.

- 9. Eleven career-counseling sessions covering almost all the aspects of commerce, 21 Curriculum related Guest Lectures, 09 Lectures on general topics, which include IPR, Cyber Awareness, Voting awareness, were held. TCS, Axa Business, Kotak Mahindra, ICICI Prudential, PMT Machines conducted online interviews and 12 students were selected.
- 10. Industrial visits to Kalyani Maxion Wheels, Dias Tools, Ramco Automatics, H. Y, Greens & K.K.Plast, visit to Deccan library and 1 visit to organic form H. Y. Greens was organized for the students.
- 11. Small Scale industry day was celebrated by organizing a visit to a small industry Grace metals Pvt. Itd by Mr. Ajit Nair ( Aluminus of MUCC). The plant mainly produces parts of boiler machines. 39 students from S.Y. and T.Y.B.Com visited the plant.
- 12. The college celebrated around 40 commemorative days. Independence Day, Republic Day, National Voters Day, National Education Day, International Human Rights Day, Indian Constitution Day, National Youth Day, Women's Day, Minorities Rights Day & Nation Road safety Week to name a few. Sindhi Matrubhasha Diwas, Behrana Saheb, Marathi Bhasha Samvardhan Pandharwada and Hindi Diwas were observed to celebrate the Indian languages, Culture and their importance.
- 13. Culfest was celebrated with a lot of enthusiasm. A host of competitions and cultural activities were organized in the span of 3 days on 17<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2023 including Painting & Sketching, Mehend, Rangoli, Traditional Dress, Photography and Videography, Dance, Singing.
- 14. Hindustani Classical (Vocal) Music event was held on the evening of November 26, 2022. The programme titled as 'Vandu Swarbhaskar' was organized in the memory of Pandit Bhimsen Joshi. Pandit Bhimsen Joshi was honored with a title "swarbhaskar'. His student Pandit Anand Bhate was invited to perform on the occasion. He presented various genres in which Pandit Bhimsen Joshi had expertise.
- 15. Two lectures were organized on new NAAC Procedures for teaching & non-teaching staff under Staff Academy.
- 16. Gymkhana: On the occasion of National Sports Day, Carom, Chess & Table Tennis tournaments were organized by Mr. Umesh Patil in which 101 students participated.
  - > 'Annual Inter Class Sports Meet' was held under which Athletics, Carom, Chess, Skipping, Plank hold, Sit ups, Table Tennis, Football, Throwball, Volleyball & Kabaddi total 18 events were organized. Total 262 students participated enthusiastically in the same.
  - The college also organised 'Inter Class Cricket Tournament' and total six teams (Total 66 students) participated enthusiastically in the same.
  - > The college hosted three sports events: 'Inter Zone Chess (Men & Women) Competition' inaugurated in the esteemed presence of Shiv Chhtrapati award winner Mr. Jayant Gokhale, Inter Collegiate Swimming, Diving & Waterpolo (Men & Women) Competition was organized at Tilak Tank, Deccan Gymkhana, inaugurated in the presence of Shiv Chhtrapati Award winner Miss. Jalaja Shirole and 'Inter Collegiate Volleyball (Women) Tournament' at Deccan Gymkhana inaugurated in the esteemed presence of Shiv Chhtrapati award winner Mrs. Priti Verma.

- Sports Fiesta 2022' was a novel attempt. The college organized five events like Football, Crickel Volleyball, Table Tennis & Carom for college alumni & current students. Total 120 students (Including Alumni & Current) participated in this event. Many students, Ex. students & executive body members of MUCC Alumni Association were present to cheer the teams.
- The college students participated in 12 Inter Collegiate Sports Competitions Archery (Women) Boxing (Men and Women), Chess (Men), Cricket (Men and Women), Cycling (Men), Football (Men Kabaddi (Women), Volleyball (Women), Shooting (Men) & Table Tennis (Men) etc. which are organized under the Pune District Zonal Sports Committee of Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune. Total 07 Students were selected for the next level i.e. Inter Zonal Level Competition.
- National Cadet Corps: Our boys and girls joined the open units of NCC (Army, Navy & Air wings) i Pune and attended the various camps organised by Maharashtra NCC battalion during the year 2022-23.
- 17. **NSS:** Apart from regular activities, a one week residential camp from 20<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> February 2023, at Dehugaon, was organized by the NSS unit. In all, 41 volunteers participated in the camp with the theme. "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsava: Yuvakancha Dhyas Gram - Shahar Vikas". Activities like a medical survey; cleanliness drive, a workshop on Martial Art and self-defense, quest lectures ,helping the temple administration, a rally with theme 'Say No to Plastic', Yoga meditation sessions and concluded with cultural programs at the entrance of Sant Tukaram Mander so that the devotees can also enjoy the devotional songs.
